#### SPECIAL PERMIT 2254 REVISION NO. 2

This Special Permit is issued pursuant to the terms of Section 71.6(a) of the Canadian Transport Commission's "Regulations for the Transportation of Dangerous Commodities by Rail" to authorize the shipment of Flammable Gas in modified CTC Specification cylinders by rail in Canada, under conditions prescribed herein, and does not relieve any shipper or carrier from compliance with any requirement of the Commission's Regulations, except as specifically stated.

### 2. COMMODITY CLASSIFICATION

Flammable gas 2.1.

### 3. COMMODITY NAME

Methyl acetylene - propadiene mixture.

### 4. IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

1060.

### 5. REGULATION AFFECTED

73.304, Specification 39.

### 6. AUTHORIZED SHIPPER

Chilton Metal Products Division, 300 Breed Street, Chilton, Wisconsin, its agents or distributors or customers.

### 7. PACKAGING DESCRIPTION

Non-refillable steel cylinder complying with C.T.C. Specification 39, except seams shall be of a brazed alloy having a melting point of not lower than 1000°F and containing not more than 60% copper.

# 8. SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Instead of "CTC 39" each cylinder shall be plainly marked "CTC SP 2254" or "CTC/DOT E6686" with letters and figures at least 1/8 of an inch high.

### 9. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

The Director of Operation shall be advised of any incident involving loss of contents and shall be provided with a summary of experience before the expiration date of the Special Permit.
