

SPECIAL PERMIT NO. 2899

This Special Permit is issued pursuant to the terms of Section 71.6(a) of the Canadian Transport Commission's "Regulations for the Transportation of Dangerous Commodities by Rail" to authorize the shipment by railway in Canada certain Flammable and Nonflammable gases in Filament wound reinforced plastic (FRP)(HW) seamless, aluminum lined compressed gas cylinders under conditions prescribed herein and does not relieve any shipper or carrier from compliance with any requirement of the Commission's Regulations, except as specifically stated.

1. BASIS

2. COMMODITY CLASSIFICATION

Flammable gas 2.1 Nonflammable gas 2.2

3. COMMODITY NAME

Authorized commodities are those gases and mixtures of gases which are approved for use with Specification CTC 3AL aluminum cylinders.

4. IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

As appropriate from Section 72.5 of the CTC Regulations for the Transportation of Dangerous Commodities by Rail.

5. REGULATION AFFECTED

73.302, 8(e) SP 1465.

6. AUTHORIZED SHIPPER

B.C. Ministry of Transportation and Highways.

7. PACKAGING DESCRIPTION

- a) Non C.T.C. specification filament wound reinforced plastic seamless, hoop wrapped, aluminum lined cylinders marked CTC/DOT E8725-3000 made of definitely prescribed materials bearing the following serial nos.: Н-180, Н-181, Н-184, Н-1019, Н-1023, Н-1025, Н-1040, Н-1091.
- b) Each cylinder must be reinspected and hydrostatically retested every three years. However, the first retest must be performed on or before April 1, 1988. Such retests must be performed in accordance with the requirements of CTC Special Permit 1465.



8. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Any incidents involving loss of contents of the package must be reported to the Director of Operation as soon as possible and a summary of shipping experience shall be rendered to this office before revisions can be considered.
